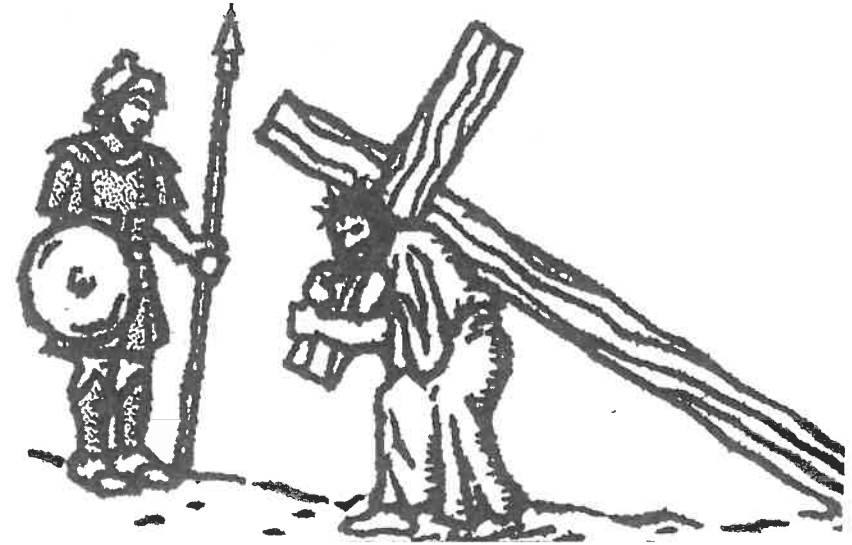


**Friday -**

**Saturday -** *The Silent Sabbath*

“By the seventh day God had finished the work. God blessed the seventh day and made it holy.”

(Genesis 2:2-3) Did God make the Sabbath to be quiet, to think, to grieve, to pray and to ask, “what’s next?”

According to the Jewish laws no work was done on the Sabbath: only enough to be able to eat and feed the livestock.

Imagine the disciples being alone after watching Jesus being crucified and buried.

What had happened to their dreams of a Savior?

How were they to follow Him? How do you think Peter was feeling that whole quiet day? Mark 14:66-72

How many times I’ve denied Jesus and “then broke down and wept.”

***Resurrection Cookies***

1. Preheat oven to 300 (important). Place 1 c. walnuts in a bag, hit with wooden spoon til small pieces. Jesus was arrested. He was beaten by Roman soldiers & the priests’ guards. John 19:1-3
2. Put 1 tsp vinegar into a mixing bowl. Taste the vinegar. When Jesus was thirsty on the cross He was given vinegar to drink. John 19:28-30
3. Add 3 egg whites. Eggs represent life. Jesus gave His life so we can have eternal life. John 10:10-11
4. Add a pinch of salt to the eggs. Taste the salt. This represents the salty tears shed by Jesus’ followers & the sadness of our own sin. Luke 23:27

6. -Beat til very frothy, **slowly** add 1 cup sugar *the sweetest part is Jesus died because He loves us, wants us to know and belong to Him. Psalms 34:8, John 3:16*

7 - Beat on high speed for 12-15 minutes til stiff peaks form.  
*white represents the purity in God's eyes when our sins have been cleansed by Jesus. Read Isaiah 1:18 and John 3:1-3*

8 - Fold in the nuts. Drop by spoonfuls on a paper covered cookie sheet. *each mound represents the rocky tomb where Jesus' body was laid. Matthew 27:57-60*

9 - Put the cookie sheet in the oven, close the door and turn the oven **OFF!** Take a piece of tape and seal the oven door. *Jesus' tomb was sealed. Matthew 27:65-66*

*Are you sad to leave the cookies all night? Jesus' followers were in despair as the tomb was sealed. John 16:20 - 22*

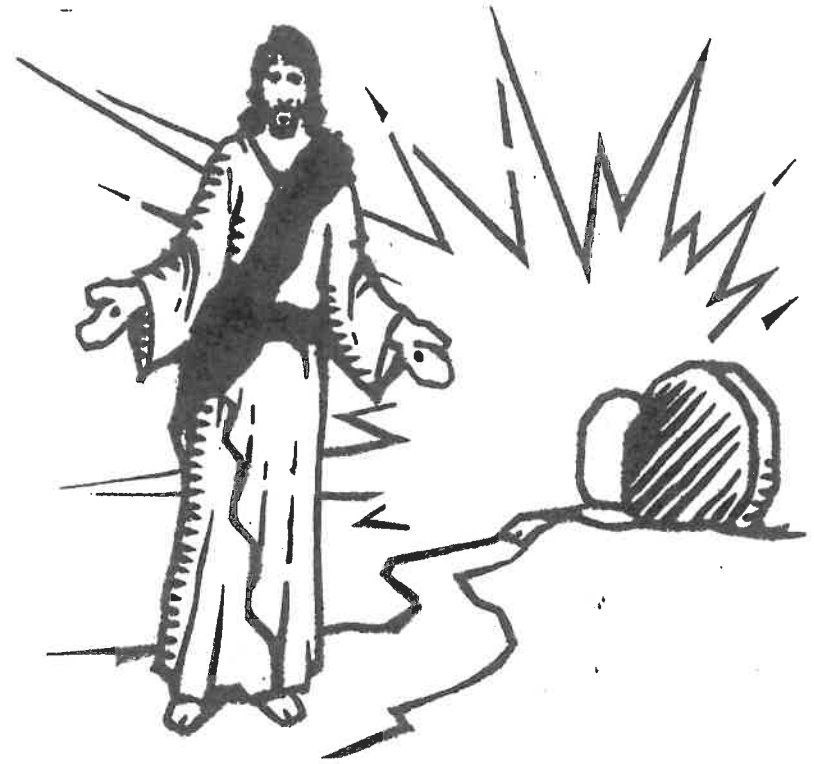
### **Easter morning:**

10 - Open the oven and give everyone a cookie. Notice the cracked surface and take a bite.

Notice  
the symbols of the empty tomb and pure white of God's glory.

The cookie is hollow; *On the first Easter, Jesus' followers were amazed to find the tomb open and empty; Jesus had risen! Matthew 28:1-9*

He is Risen!



Our hope: "\_\_\_\_\_ with your mouth that \_\_\_\_\_ is
