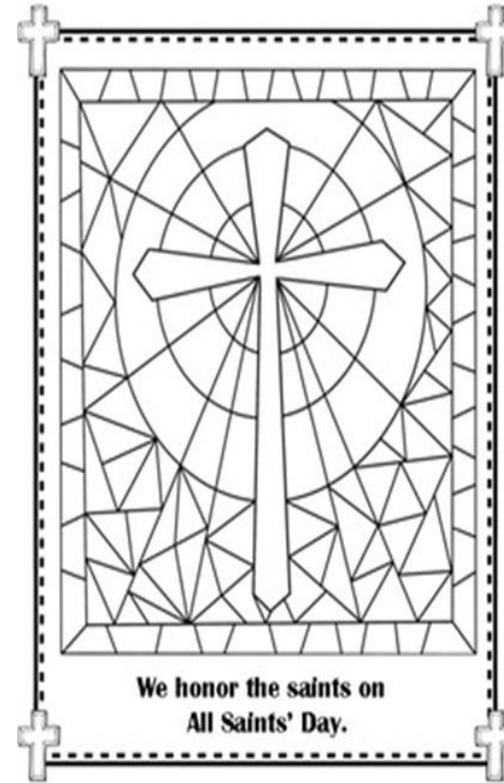
dead. Goblins and witches with cats are ancient symbols of the Devil! Poor people used to dress up and perform to get food.
